- Title in initial capitals, written in Times New Roman, 12 point bold font size with centre alignment.
- Name of all authors should be written in initial capitals in 10 points Times New Roman font.
- The oral presentation must be prepared with PowerPoint. The PPT must contain 10-15 slides focusing on aim, method, result and conclusion. (Max. 5 min.)
- The main text of the abstract and full paper should be written in Times New Roman 10 points font.

POSTER PRESENTATION

- Poster size 3 ft. x 4 ft. with one hole on each corner.
- Poster should be preferably of flex material. Title of the poster should be mentioned at the top, and name of author/co-authors at the back of poster.
